



Burt Block Party FAQ's

Where do I enter the event?

Entry for ticket holders is available through Gate 1 on Ellice Avenue and Gate 2 on Notre Dame Avenue.

Where can I find parking?

There is a variety of parking spaces near the Burton Cummings Theatre. We recommend visiting the Downtown Winnipeg BIZ parking information located [HERE](#)

Will there be an area to secure my bike?

Bike rack will be available to lock and store your bicycle on the corner of Notre Dame Avenue and Donald Street.

What methods of payment can I use?

True North strongly encourages attendees to use debit and credit cards via tap technology for all transactions. Cash will be accepted, but guests should prepare for designated lines and or longer wait times. An ATM is located inside the Burton Cummings Theatre.

Where can I purchase tickets or get assistance with my ticket?

The Box Office is located at Gate 1 on Ellice Avenue and will open at 4:30PM. In advance of the event please contact info@tnse.com.

What seating is available?

This is general admission event. Guests are encouraged to bring their own lawn chair. Seating options such as picnic tables and stand-up bar tables will also be available.

Is there an area I can check items?

Bag and Coat check will be available on site for \$5. Guests will be responsible to keep all other personal items with them.

What is available for food and beverage?

Local food trucks, light concession snacks, non-alcoholic and alcoholic drinks will be available. Please

remember to bring your contactless payment! Outside food and beverage is not permitted. Guests can bring in an empty water bottle, a water fountain will be available inside the theatre.

Will there be concert merchandise available?

Artist merchandise will be available. There is a limited selection so please come early!

What items can or can't I bring to the Burt Block Party?

Permitted:

- Bags no larger than 14"x14"x6" - Bags larger than this will need to be checked or returned to vehicle or other location.

Not Permitted

- Bags larger than 14"x14"x6"
- Outside food and beverage
- Coolers, tarps or blankets
- Pets (service animals only)
- Knives or other weapons
- Any object deemed to potentially pose a risk to guests, employees, or the artists, at the discretion of True North

Is there a smoking area?

A designated smoking area will be available in the event site.

What washroom facilities will be available?

Porta-potties are available outdoors and restrooms located inside the Burton Cummings Theatre will also be available.

Can I leave and re-enter the event?

Re-entry is not permitted.

Is the event wheelchair accessible?

Yes. Please speak to one of our team members on site for additional assistance.
